The three dinners will take place at the following venues:

Stocks Hotel: arguably the best hotel in Sark. We will have exclusive use of their restaurant for one evening. A tasting of local gins is thrown in for good measure.

Nova's: Mads, the owner of the restaurant, is the island's famed desert chef.

Hathaway's: located in the Seigneurie Gardens, this restaurant will serve lunch and dinner for us in a Marquee, and keep us lubricated with its Horsebox Bar.

This event will also make networking easier.

Meeting like-minded people is one of the great benefits of attending the events I organise, and I want you to easily take home many new contacts!

Throughout the three days, I'll be making plenty of personal introductions.

FAQs



What's included in the trip? You need to book your own accommodation and the flights to/from Guernsey. We will help you choose the right accommodation on Sark.



What's the weather like? September is one of the nicest months to visit Sark. Obviously, the weather varies and we cannot guarantee sunshine – but we are hoping for an Indian summer weekend!



Who is attending? Usually, my events attract a broad range of guests aged 20-80 years (with most in their 40s and 50s). Many will likely travel from outside the UK.



Can I choose the activities on the island? We will offer multiple options and timings for the activities on Friday 11 September. The sooner you book, the sooner you can book your specific activities and timeslots.



What level of fitness is required? Sark is small and we are not planning any extreme activities, but there are no cars. If you struggle to walk, this trip might *not* be for you.



Can I also visit Guernsey? We are organising some sightseeing since you'll be passing through Guernsey on the way to Sark. If you are interested in Guernsey, I recommend you come a day earlier or stay a day longer. I can help with recommendations for visiting Guernsey.



Can I travel via Jersey? While it is possible to travel to Sark via Jersey, it is generally not recommended due to the longer distance and lack of connections. Speak to me if you want to discuss this further.



Do you cater to individual requests? If you have any, let me know and I'll do my best to help you!

Securing your space

The package is GBP 1,150 per person (EUR 1,350 / USD 1,550).

Included are:

- All meals, drinks and activities as mentioned in the programme.
- Transport in Guernsey and Sark.
- A donation of GBP 200 for the Seigneurie Garden Trust, a charity that operates the Seigneurie Gardens for the benefit of Sark.

The trip is sold "at cost" with a small buffer for cost overruns.

Flights to/from Guernsey and accommodation in Sark are not included.

Invoice provided on request (please email me your company name and address).

What I need from you at the time of booking:

- Name(s) of guests.
- One-sentence bio and/or link to LinkedIn profile.
- Any dietary restrictions.

You will then receive from me:

- A list of recommended accommodation on the island.
- Bank details for transfer (HSBC). WISE also available. PayPal with 3% surcharge.
- An itinerary of activities so you can register your preferred time slots.

All bookings are non-refundable. However, if you've got to cancel I will try to find a replacement.
